The EAA Young Eagles Camp is designed as an introduction to the wonderful world of aviation. This program will use small group activities and close counselor relationships to present the basics of flight in a "science camp" format that is a unique combination of fun and discovery.

Activities at the EAA Young Eagles Camp are designed to interest and challenge 12 and 13

year old and include activities such as:

Wing Construction - Learn the intricacies of a fabricated wing by building a wing rib.

Aeromodeling - Build and fly a simple balsa glider and a rubber powered model.

Ground School - Learn the basics of flight through an interactive computer simulator ground

school by flying designed missions or flying your own mission.

Airplanes - Learn about aviation history and flight.

- Visit Pioneer Airport
- •Watch flight demonstrations
- •Experience the thrill of flight in both an airplane and helicopter

# Young Eagles Camp Scholarship:

Local Chapter 944 of the Experimental Aircraft Association is seeking candidates to send to the EAA Young Eagles Camp that is held each summer in Oshkosh, WI. The Academy consists of five days of exposure to aviation topics and is held at the site of Oshkosh fly-in, aviation's largest event. EAA's Young Eagle Camp will occur from June 22<sup>nd</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Additional details on the event may be found at: <u>http://eaa.org/youth</u> EAA Chapter 944 will pay all registration fee for each youth (camper), that is chosen by Chapter 944 members, to attend. Registration fee includes all instructional materials, meals and lodging. The campers will stay in the beautiful EAA Air Academy Lodge located at EAA's AirVenture Museum in Oshkosh Wisconsin. Participants will share a bunkroom with three other campers and bathroom facilities centrally located on the same floor. High standards of safety, appearance, and cleanness are an EAA tradition and backed by American Camp Association accreditation.

Transportation to and from Oshkosh is the responsibility of the participant with free pick-up provided from the Appleton, Wisconsin airport for those wishing to go by commercial flight. All necessary Oshkosh area transportation is provided by EAA vehicles.

### Scholarship Applications Process:

Eligible applicants: Boys or girls, must be at least 12 but no more than 13 years old by the first day of camp. Each applicant must complete a written letter that answers the following questions:

- Why do you want to attend EAA's Young Eagle Camp?
- What aviation experiences, education or training do you have to date?
- What aviation experiences would you like to gain from your EAA Air Academy experiences?
- What aviation related goals do you have that could be further advanced from your experiences at the EAA Young Eagle Camp?,

## Your application should be completed and must be submitted to EAA Chapter 944 by December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023.

Selection of the winning candidates will be based on the evaluation of application materials and appropriate follow-up by Chapter 944 members. The selection of the winner(s) will be made by December 31, 2023

## Application Requirements:

- Signatures by both applicant and parent or legal guardian are required.
- Application must be complete and legible for consideration and must be submitted to EAA Chapter 944 at address listed on page 4.
- If you are selected for the scholarship, EAA will send you a packet of information that will include the following:
  - Permission to participate
  - Liability Waiver
  - Release and indemnification
  - Health forms
  - Travel forms
  - Important travel and contact information
  - If selected, a physical exam within the l2 months prior to the camp's starting date is required.

All applications shall be subject to being interviewed by EAA Chapter 944 members. We receive several quality applications each year, so please don't delay in applying.
