Personal Interview

Anyone selected as a possible "Learn To Fly Scholarship" recipient, will be asked to attend a regular monthly meeting of EAA Chapter 944 prior to being selected to receive the scholarship. The interview will give the Chapter an opportunity to meet the candidate and also to go over the scholarship requirements with applicant. Scholarship candidate will be contacted by a member of the Chapter to schedule a date for the interview.

If you are chosen as a recipient of EAA Chapter 944 "Learn To Fly Scholarship":

- > Student will be responsible for all books, supplies and other training materials required by flight school.
- > Student will be required to have successfully passed a 3rd Class Medical.
- ➤ The scholarship limit is set to \$1,500 (Chapter 944's obligation) for each student.
- Student will only be reimbursed for flight training expenses incurred after he/she has satisfied the requirements for a Student Pilot's Certificate, signed off by a CFI to fly solo. and up to successfully meeting the requirements for their Private Pilot's License.
- ➤ EAA Chapter 944 will reimburse one-half of each eligible, paid receipt for flight instructions. Student will not be reimbursed for Ground School or books.
- Student must submit a copy of all receipt(s), in person, to Chapter 944 at one of it's regular monthly meetings for reimbursement.
- Chapter 944 reserves the right to submit your name and picture to a local media and the EAA organization to publicize your achievements.
- Chapter 944 will reimburse a student pilot only for training that was received within 120 days of being notified as a scholarship recipient. However, additional time may be granted by Chapter 944 if:
 - > student pilot's instructor request additional time in writing.
 - > Chapter 944 agrees to the requested extension.
- EAA Chapter 944 recommends that any student pilot renting an aircraft for their pilot instruction, first obtain Renters Insurance before starting their flight instruction.
- Anyone accepting our Learn To Fly scholarship, will be expected to participate in Chapter 944 Club activities including our regular monthly meetings and our annual Flyin.
